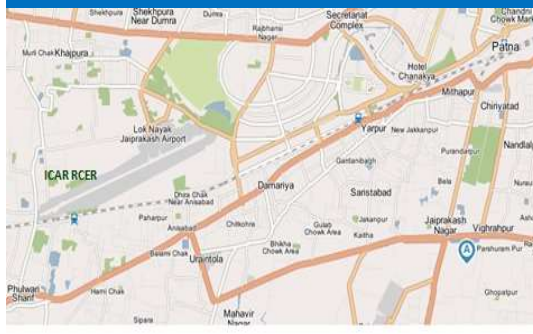

Application Procedure

Interested participants must apply online using CBP portal at www.iasri.res.in/cbp. Participants have to register and create an account on the CBP site and later log in to their respective account for applying online for the training program. After online filing the application form, print out of the same is generated which has to be duly approved by the competent authority of the organisation and the scanned copy of approved application must be uploaded on the CBP portal or sent to the Course Director or course coordinators by post or email. In case of any difficulty in applying through CBP portal, the participants may send the filled application form duly approved by the competent authority in the format given on the website of our institute www.icarrcer.in to the course director on the given address. The selected participants will have to pay Rs 50/- as registration fees at the time of registration in the Short course in form of DD/postal order in favour of ICAR Unit ICAR RCER, Patna, payable at SBI, BV College Complex Branch, Patna, IFSC code SBIN0009006.

About the Course

The course is designed in a manner to provide the participants with theoretical as well practical knowledge on livelihood improvement of rural youth through interventions of livestock and poultry. It also covers field visits for practical training on virtual glimpse of such intervention. The course includes lectures from experts in area of livestock, poultry, animal health, nutrition, economics, statistical models, women empowerment, value addition, entrepreneurship, farming system models and success stories. Experts from leading Institutes of India will be sharing their expertise in these training programs. Ultimate objective of the training is to provide the trainees with holistic knowledge and training on various aspects of livelihood improvement based on various interventions

Eligibility

The candidates holding the rank of SMS/Assistant Professor/Scientists and above or equivalent in the National Agriculture Research System (NARS) including State Agriculture Universities, Krishi Vigyan Kendras, Agriculture and Allied Science Faculties of other universities and possessing Master's Degree or Doctoral Degree in Agriculture Extension, Veterinary Sciences, Animal Sciences, Agriculture and Allied Subjects and relevant basic sciences are eligible

Boarding, lodging and Travel

Free boarding and lodging, as per ICAR approved norms will be arranged in the Institute Guest house. Actual TA will be paid on production of necessary documents by the participants. The selected participants will be paid for the journey, to and fro, restricted to AC-II tier fare or bus as the case may be as per approved norms. Patna city, which is well connected by air, rail and road to major cities of India, The Patna railway station is approximately 10 km and bus stand is about 14 km from the Institute. Important landmark for reaching the Institute is Patna Airport and Bihar Veterinary College which are located within 1 Km distance from the Institute.
